Tangub City Hosts One Asenso MisOcc Palaro 2024

For the first time in the history of Misamis Occidental, a provincial athletic event was held on February 7-11, 2024 at Tangub City. Gov. Henry S. Oaminal initiated this move in preparation for the coming Northern Mindanao Regional Athletic Association (NMRAA) in May of this year. This is to select the best athletes from among the four Department of Education divisions of Misamis Occidental to represent the province in the regional athletic event.

In the past years, the Schools Division of Tangub City, Ozamiz City, Oroquieta City and Misamis Occidental attended NMRAA as separate delegations. With this, competition, however friendly and sportsmanly, existed among the four divisions which were just within the same province. This year, provincial athletic meet was held to foster unity, save on cost and select the best athletes to represent the province.

Tangub City Mayor Sabiniano "Ben" Canama mo

bilized all sectors of the city to participate in the preparation for the Palaro. In the several coordination meetings held for this purpose, the task forces formed in preparation for the opening of the Panguil Bay Bridge in June

were mandated to prioritize the preparation for Palaro. Hence, infrastructure support was directed to check that water, power, toilet and bath, sleeping and cooking facilities were put in place. Local government employees were

assigned to help in the massive cleaning, clearing and greening of main streets, along with the barangay officials and constituents. Flaglets and bunting were installed along the streets to welcome the

The Governor's Night, A Celebration of UNITY and PROGRESS



TANGUB CITY, Misamis Occidental - The evening of February 8, 2024, was a night to remember as the province of Misamis Occidental came together for the Governor's Night during the One Asenso Misamis Occidental Palaro 2024. The event, held at the People's Gymnasium, Tangub City, was in honor of the working Governor Henry S. Oaminal.

The gathering brought together key figures, which includes the Regional Director of DepEd, provincial and division superintendents, DepEd personnel, provincial board members, city

and municipal mayors with their respective councilors. It was an evening of beautiful music, of collective spirit and camaraderie that united all Misamisnons.

The program started with an invocation, followed by a fellowship dinner. The arrival of Governor Oaminal at 8:00 PM was met with fervor and rejoicing.

Dr. Reynaldo A. Manuel Jr, acknowledged the province-wide support for the youth, citing the example of Sapangdalaga's first gold win in swimming. He was optimistic for the province's future in sports, not just in regional or national but also in the international arena.

MisOcc seeks to climb for Northern Mindanao’s top provinces in sports

Misamis Occidental - Parallel to pushing an effective sports development program for young Misamisnons, Governor Henry Oaminal is also hoping the province would climb as one of the top provinces in Northern Mindanao in terms of Sports development initiatives.

Governor Oaminal seeks to create a conducive environment and enhance sporting opportunities that would lead to higher participation rates among Misamisnons, not only in the region but also conquering the national and international sports arena.

“The goal is to put MisOcc on top of the region. Of course, the long reach goal is total development of sports program to the youth. Dili lang initiatory on top of region 10, as much possible nga sa development sa atong Kabataan, dili lang regional, dili lang national but even international arena,” Oaminal said during the Asenso Provincial Meet Executive Committee meeting at the Provincial Capitol in Oroquieta City on January 26.

The meeting was attended sports coordinators from the Department of Education, local chief executives and several educators in the province.

The agenda of the meeting revolves in the conduct of sports activities



within the province and for the preparation of first-ever One Asenso MisOcc Provincial Athletic Association PALARO 2024, including the eyed Regional Meet 2024, Palarong Pambansa, and other sports training.

The governor vowed he will continue advocating for the empowerment of young and talented Misamisnons when it comes to sports.

Gov. Oaminal said he is willing to utilize the province’s resources to make sure every youth will be given chances in pursuit of sports excellence.

“Na encourage ko sa pagbisita sa PSC Chairman kung unsay other mga avenues nga ang atong mga Kabataan ma- train and then maka-participate sa national and international competition,” he said.

“So dili lang nato i-limit sa DepEd although ang atong first vehicle of this development is the DepEd

program but ultimately para gyud ni sa total sports development sa atong mga Kabataan,” he added.

Gov. Oaminal feted the provincial’s sports committee in providing a conducive sports environment for Misamisnons athletes, making them nationally and globally competitive in athletic aspects.

“Dili lang ni karong regional meet but continuous training sa inyong taga-tagsa ka division. By so doing, basin in the next three years duna nata’y mga MisOcc nga mo emerge ug maka-produce ta og champion sa atong probinsya,” he said

Gov. Oaminal urged the entire provincial government along with the 17 local government units in the Misamis Occidental and four DepEd Divisions to rally behind his call for “One Misamis Occidental” sports program. ##

Nagpahigayon ang siyudad sa Tangub ug bansay-bansay adlawng Biyernes, Pebrero 2, 2024 sa nagkalain-laing sektor sa siyudad bahin sa maayong kinaiya nga angay batunan sa kada Tangubanon nga naglangkob sa: empleyado, barangay functionaries and constituents, vendors, mga eskwelahan, ug uban pa.

Ang nagpahigayon sa pagbansay mga pinili nga empleyado nga gikan sa local government unit aron

silang mag orient sa nagkalain-laing sektor.

Kini dili lamang gihimo isip pangandam sa pagpahigayon sa 2024 One Asenso Misamis Occidental Provincial Athletic Meet nga gipahigayon sa siyudad sa Tangub (Pebrero 7-11, 2024) kondili pagpangandam usab sa umaabot nga pag-abli sa Panguil Bay Bridge. Gilau-man nga sa pagbukas sa tulay, modagsa ang mga tawo dire sa siyudad sama sa mga negosyante, estudyante, turista, taga Tangub nga dugay wala nakauli ug mga bakasyonista nga parente sa mga lumulupyo dire.

LGU All-Out Support to Provincial Palaro: The Billeting Quarters

In two weeks of preparation, the City Government of Tangub, led by “Yanong Mayor” Ben Canama mobilized personnel and logistical resources to support the Dept of Education Tangub City Division for the holding of provincial athletic event on February 7-11, 2024.

Sixteen (16) billeting quarters were allocated with one quarter reserved for more or less 4, 500 delegates from the three (3) cities and 14 municipalities of Misamis Occidental. Maquilao Integrated School housed 375 delegates from Plaridel. Maloro Integrated School accom-

modated 318 participants from Aloran; San Apolinario Elementary School housed 155 from Sinacaban. At the Northwestern Mindanao State College Junior High School Building were 162 delegates from Lopez Jaena. Tangub Central School was temporary home for 479 delegates from the City itself for the duration of the athletic event.

Lorenzo Tan National High School accommodated the delegates from Oroquieta City while Pangabuan Integrated Schools warmly welcomed the 318 delegates from Bonifacio and Don Victoriano. At St. Michael’s High School, there were 229 delegates from Jimenez. The 500 delegates from Ozamiz City were accommodated at Sta. Maria National High School. Polao Integrated School accommodated 340 delegates from Panaon and Tudela.

Tangub City National High School



(Senior HS Building) housed 378 delegates from Clarin, while Tangub City National High School (Junior HS Building) accommodated 295 delegates from Baliangao and Sapang Dalaga. The 443 technical officials and officials were billeted at Tangub City Global College (TCGC).

Barangay officials and functionaries, assigned departments of the local government and clustered scho-

ols prepared the billeting quarters making sure that light, water, toilet and bath were adequately installed. These groups also formally welcomed the delegates through a program in their respective billeting quarters. Throughout the duration of the athletic event, the same group monitored the billeting quarters for problems and issues that the delegates may encounter. ##
