



CHO Distributes Mosquito Nets to Dengue-Affected Residents in Bocator

Tangub City - Responding to the recent surge in dengue cases, the City Health Office (CHO) took swift action by distributing mosquito nets to some residents in Barangay Bocator. On June 13, 2023, at 2:00 PM, the CHO personnel visited the barangay to provide much-needed protection against the dengue-carrying mosquitoes.

Barangay Bocator has been facing an alarming rise in dengue cases, with nine reported cases as of June.

In response to the dengue outbreak, the CHO has been actively conducting dengue awareness campaigns in the affected areas. The focus has been on Purok 2 and Purok 6 in Barangay Bocator, where health officials have also been conducting larval surveys to identify and eliminate mosquito breeding sites.

The distribution of mosquito nets aims to provide additional protection to residents, especially those living in the high-risk areas. These mosquito nets were sourced from the regional authorities and are a crucial part of the city's efforts to combat the spread of dengue.

Residents who have contracted dengue from Purok 2 and Purok 6 were prioritized to receive the mosquito nets to ensure their safety and prevent further transmission of the disease.

The CHO emphasized the importance of self-protection measures, urging all residents to remain vigilant and proactive in preventing dengue. Regularly cleaning surroundings, removing stagnant water where mosquitoes breed, and using mosquito nets are crucial steps in safeguarding against the disease.

Barangay Bocator reported eight new dengue cases, while Barangay Isidro D. Tan has been grappling with dengue cases since January of this year.

Mrs. Meme Enriquez and her team from the CHO focused on delivering Dengue awareness primarily to the puroks (zones) with reported cases. In Barangay Bocator, Purok 2 and Purok 6 received special attention during the IEC campaign, while in Barangay Isidro D. Tan, Purok 7 was the focal point for dengue awareness, alongside

The CHO continues to stress the importance of taking preventive measures to combat the dengue outbreak in the city. Health officials urged residents to remain vigilant, eliminate breeding grounds for mosquitoes, and seek immediate medical attention if any dengue symptoms are observed.

As the city grapples with the steady increase of dengue cases, the CHO reaffirms its commitment to ensuring the health and safety of Tangub City's residents. By conducting IEC campaigns and distributing mosquito nets, the health authorities are working relentlessly to mitigate the impact of dengue and promote a healthier environment for all. ##





In his talk, RD Bayocot stressed the importance of consistency to turn school's good practices into habit and concurrently into a culture of excellence.

"The department should be striving for foundational and functional literacy wherein every learner has mastered the skills he/she must be learning in a specific area and stage," he said.

"The gauge of school's performance is measured as outputs and outcomes and not the mode of deliveries," Dr. Art stressed.

In the latter part of his talk, he led a meaningful activity on renewal of commitment as effective leaders who will serve as wheels to keep the Department of Education running smoothly.

In conclusion, SDS Shambaeh A. Abantas-USman, expressed that as a leader one should walk the talk. She reiterated what RD had said that in leading a school,

good performance should be as important as maintaining good relationship among the teachers and people in the community. ##

PANGUIL BAY BRIDGE | UPDATE

Former DPWH Sec. Villar Highlights Accomplishments of PBB Construction

June 12, 2023, Tangub City – Former DPWH Secretary, Senator Mark Villar visits the PBBP construction site to assess the progress and highlight accomplishments made while he was in service.

When Mark A. Villar took the helm of the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), the government launched the Build, Build, Build program. It is by far the biggest, boldest, and most ambitious step taken by the Philippine government to ramp up infrastructure in the country. Part of its inter-island linkage and mega bridge program is the Panguil Bay Bridge. It is a 3.169-kilometer bridge that will connect the city of Tangub in Misamis Occidental to the municipality of Tubod in Lanao del Norte.

During his visit, Senator Villar carried out a thorough ocular inspection of the ongoing PBBP (Panguil Bay Bridge Project) construction in an effort to highlight the tangible outcomes of his time serving as the DPWH Secretary under the administration of former President Rodrigo Roa Duterte. In hindsight, the Panguil Bay Bridge ranks as one of his most significant initiatives, adding to his legacy as the forefront of the Philippines' infrastructure development.

From the groundbreaking on November 28, 2018, up until today when the bridge is nearing completion, his support never ceases. Now, as he walked through the site, the senator pointed out various structures and improvements, explaining their significance and the benefits they would bring to local communities, especially the residents of Lanao Del Norte and Misamis Occidental. Once the bridge is completed, it will only take seven minutes to reach Tubod Municipality in Lanao Del Norte from Tangub City in Misamis Occidental using the bridge, compared to the 2.5 hours it would take via the 100-km route

Tangub-Molave-Tubod Road or via Tangub-Kapatagan-Tubod Road.

Senator Villar was also able to meet with the project's engineers and construction employees during the ocular inspection. He complimented their devotion and hard work, recognizing their significant contributions to the achievement of the PBBP's objectives.

Speaking to the media present, Senator Villar expressed his gratitude for the trust and support given to him during his tenure as DPWH Secretary. He highlighted the immense progress made in infrastructure development during the Duterte administration and reiterated his commitment to continue championing projects that would further enhance the nation's infrastructure network in support of President Ferdinand Marcos Jr.'s Build Better More (BBM) program.

The Build Better More is an infrastructure program that targets to expand the previous administration's Build, Build, Build (BBB) program. This infrastructure program seeks to address the inadequacies of the country's infrastructure which hinders national development.



AICS Provides Financial Assistance Amounting to Over 412,000 Pesos in Two Weeks

Tangub City, July 19, 2023 - The Assistance for Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) has extended a total of 412,000 pesos and more in financial aid to deserving beneficiaries, according to the most recent data from the City Management System (CMS) as of July 19, 2023.

The AICS has been actively providing assistance to the people of Tangub City, especially those facing financial hardships. Notably, within the first two weeks of July, the AICS disbursed financial aid to support the urgent needs of the community.

During the initial week of July, the AICS released cash assistance to 12 beneficiaries on July 3, amounting to 37,000 pesos. On July 4, 17 beneficiaries received financial aid, totaling 94,000 pesos. On July 5, only 3 beneficiaries were assisted, receiving a total of 16,500 pesos. Similarly, on July 6, 4 beneficiaries received financial assistance totaling 23,500 pesos, with two of them receiving medical aid.

On July 11, the AICS extended help to 24 beneficiaries, releasing a total of 88,500 pesos. On July 17, 17 beneficiaries were provided financial aid, totaling 86,500 pesos. The assistance continued until July 13, when 14 beneficiaries received a total of 66,000 pesos.

The AICS continues to process cash assistance applications, with further releases expected in the coming days. The Asenso Tangub Administration remains steadfast in its commitment to serve the needs of the people, especially those who are most vulnerable in the community.

As the city faces various challenges, the AICS plays a crucial role in providing timely financial support to those in crisis situations. Tangub City - The Asenso Tangub Administration, through the Electrical Department of the City Engineering Office (CEO), has successfully energized a total of 193 households as of June 19, 2023.

The electrification initiative is one of the flagship programs of the Asenso Tangub Administration, promising to deliver improved services to the residents. The administration had set a target of energizing 300 households in the first batch of the program.

Caniangan with 14 households, Brgy. Simasay with 7 households, Brgy. Mantic with 2 households, Brgy. Paiton with 7 households, Brgy. Bintana with 6 households, Brgy. Silangit with 9 households, Brgy. Guilanaban with 5

households, Brgy. Pangabuan with 12 households, and Brgy. Labuyo with 1 household, among others.

As the program continues, a second batch is being prepared to install electricity for more households in need.

KKPP Extends Aid and Service to 1,297 Beneficiaries in June 2023

In a recent report from the KKPP office, the Kalipay Kasakit Pag-inunungay Program (KKPP) has made a significant impact on the lives of 1,297 individuals from February to May of this year. The KKPP, with the tagline "Problema Mo Isumbong Mo Kay Mayor Ben," is a program dedicated to providing assistance to the most vulnerable members of the community, specifically those who fall under the category of the "3 Ls" – least, lost, and last – and are in need of support.

Despite the personal difficulties that could snuff her dreams and aspirations, Rosalyn Alforque’s inspiring story speaks of triumph over adversity.

Born as a normal child, fate dealt Rosalyn a heavy hand when she contracted polio at a young age that caused her with walking difficulties.

However, this setback did not keep her from her dreams of finishing college. At nine years old, Rosalyn went with her younger sibling and bravely enrolled herself despite her physical limitations.

Rosalyn arduously faced the first years of school. Being a child with a disability, she became a target

for bullies in elementary school. But she remained determined and did not let these bullies dampen her spirit.

Rosalyn continued her studies until senior high. Upon completing her secondary education, Rosalyn found herself at a crossroads. She took on the physical constraints of college life. Climbing up and down the stairs was physically exhausting. Yet, her determination to learn prevailed, and she pressed on, and enrolled in college despite her difficulties.

She persevered and excelled in college; she eventually graduated with Academic Distinction in a 4-year degree in Office Administration from the Governor Alfonso D. Tan College (GADTC).

In a turn of events, Rosalyn’s perseverance caught the attention of Mayor Ben during the GADTC graduation ceremony on July 28, the same year. The mayor recognized her achievements and determination despite her circumstances. He awarded her with financial assistance and, even more importantly, offered her a job in the GADTC – Alumni Affairs Office.

Overwhelmed by emotion, Rosalyn stepped into the Alumni Affairs Office as she begins to be a part of the work force. The recognition and support from her community, especially Mayor Ben, made her realize that her efforts were recognized. Filled with gratitude and renewed purpose, she set out to contribute her skills to the community that had supported her throughout her journey.

However, her inspiring tale does not end there. Days later, Governor Henry Oaminal also acknowledged Rosalyn’s remarkable journey. He commended Rosalyn for becoming a role model to others. He presented her with a Php 10,000 cash award, and acknowledged her as an inspiration to all who face disability.

Rosalyn Alforque’s journey serves as a reminder that challenges can be overcome with determination and faith. Her triumph over adversity has ignited hope in the hearts of many, empowering them to embrace education and rise above their struggles.
