Sa mga paghinabi sa katawhan, nasayran sa Mayor nga daghan pa kaayo ang wala pa sukad nakaadto sa mga nailhang landmarks dire sa siyudad. Ang biyahe mo gikan alas dos sa hapon ug mahanal alas dyes sa gabii.





The story said that longtime ago, the inhabitants burned out a big tree which its flame lasted for several months even heavy rains cannot demolished the fire.


The inhabitants of the place as well as "kaingeros" used fire or flame for kaingin.




