**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 10**  
**Series of 2023**

**AN ORDER DELEGATING TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND OTHER CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS CERTAIN POWERS, FUNCTIONS, AND DUTIES, PRIMARILY THE AUTHORITY TO SIGN DOCUMENTS FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE OF TANGUB CITY, DEFINING SAID DELEGATION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, Section 455 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, explicitly provides the powers, function and duties of the City Mayor as the local chief executive of the city government, and is further mandated to promptly exercise and perform the same and ensure an efficient, effective and economical governance, to protect and carry-out the interests, and promote the general welfare of the city and its people;

**WHEREAS**, considering the magnitude of the functions and duties of the City Mayor and the need to provide prompt and exigent actions to all matters and businesses required from the City Mayor and the City Government of Tangub in general, there is a need to delegate certain powers, functions, duties and authorities of the City Mayor to the City Administrator and to other persons;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, SABINIANO S. CANAMA**, City Mayor of Tangub, in the exigency of public service, do hereby delegate and order the City Administrator, with full authority and responsibility, to assist in the prompt and efficient delivery of government services and do and perform the powers, functions, and duties, primarily the signing for and in my behalf of all documents necessary to carry out the following, to wit:

- 1) Forward propose legislative measures to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, and as may be directed, express its urgency, as often as may be deemed necessary, and provide such information and data needed or requested by the latter in the performance of its legislative functions;
- 2) Carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disaster and calamities;
- 3) Invite or call, at such time and place and on such subject as may be deemed important any national official or employee stationed in or assigned to the city, including elective and appointive officials of the city, for the promotion of the general welfare of the local government unit and its inhabitants, to advise the City Government of Tangub and coordinate with said officials or employees in the formulation and implementation of plans, programs and projects in the city;
- 4) Report on all matters pertinent to the management, administration and development of the city and all information and data relative to its political,
